To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting an appropriation of \$25,897.00 in the Grant Fund of the Department of Human Services Salary and Wages Account (\$1,233.00) and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (24,664.00). Supportive Housing program funds have been awarded to the Department of Human Services by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and authorized under the Stewart B. McKinney Homeless Assistance Act. The Department of Human Services will use these funds to cover administrative costs and to contract with the Cambridge Housing Authority to provide housing at the St. Paul's Residence. Persons served under this project are formerly homeless individuals with disabilities who require ongoing supportive services in order to maintain their housing.
