WHEREAS: Mary Joe Frug was a greatly respected Professor of Law at the New England School of Law where she was a leading scholar of feminist legal studies and an adherent of the critical legal theory movement; and

WHEREAS: Mary Joe Frug was widely recognized for her scholarship and earned the respect of her colleagues and the love of her students; and

WHEREAS: Mary Joe Frug found time to nurture a great many warm friendships and to support her family and friends in innumerable ways; and

WHEREAS: Mary Joe Frug was born in St. Louis, Missouri, graduated from Wellesley College in 1963, and George Washington Law School in 1968, and received a Masters in Law from Columbia Law School; and

WHEREAS: Mary Joe Frug had a history of community service, working in neighborhood legal services, teaching at Villanova, and later at New England School of Law; and

WHEREAS: Mary Joe Frug was a resident of Cambridge on Sparks Street where she lived with husband, Professor Gerald Frug, son Stephen, and daughter Emily; and

RESOLVED: That this City Council expresses its deepest regret at the death of Professor Mary Joe Frug and further sends its sincerest condolences to the Frug family; and further be it

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution for presentation to the family of Mary Joe Frug.
