WHEREAS:

This City Council wishes to join with the Tenant Council of the Miller River Apartments on March 26, 1976 to record for all time, their admiration to M. I. T. for their response to a critical housing shortage which resulted in the construction of 794 units of housing at Millers River, the Daniel F. Burns Apartments in North Cambridge and the Lyndon B. Johnson Apartments on Erie Street, an effort by a private institution which is unparalleled anywhere in New England and matched by few in the entire United States, therefore be it
