WHEREAS: The United States Marine Corps Reserve is launching the 29th straight year of its national Toys for Tots program, chaired by Henry "The Fonz Winkler", and

WHEREAS: Last year the Corps collected nearly 5 1/2 million toys for needy children across the country, youngsters who would otherwise have gone without Christmas toys; and

WHEREAS: The 1st Battalion 25th Marines turned over 1/2 million pounds of toys in this region alone; and

WHEREAS: Several Cambridge organizations will be this year's distribution centers; and

WHEREAS: The Crimson Galeria Mall, 57 Boylston Street, Harvard Square has been named the Cambridge collection center,

THEREFORE I, Alfred E. Vellucci, Mayor of the City of Cambridge, proclaim Friday, November 26 through Wednesday, December 22, "Toys for Tots" Month in Cambridge and urge all citizens to bring their gifts for needy children to the Crimson Galeria Mall collection center.
