MIT has informed the Rent Control Board that the six new units of rent control housing which were constructed pursuant to the terms of the removal permits are almost completed. As a result, MIT will shortly seek to relocate the units at 55-57 Blanche Street and 38 Green Street. These dates are earlier than those which were previously anticipated. MIT, through their counsel, has requested a meeting with me, on May 2, to discuss permits to construct foundations on the relocation sites, including obtaining the Board's sign-off on those permits.
