ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to consult with the Director of Traffic and Parking, the Police and Department of Public Works Commissioners for the purpose of taking the necessary steps to assure that several parking spaces will be kept available at the Lafayette Square voting site throughout the day on November 5, 1991, Election Day; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to report back to the Council on this matter within one week.
