WHEREAS:-

John J. Hagerty was one of the most illustrious and respected citizens of Cambridge having served as Chairman of the Cambridge Housing Authority and Chapter Chairman of the Cambridge Red Cross, and

WHEREAS:-

John J. Hagerty was a graduate of Holy Cross College and Georgetown Law School and was the recipient of an honorary Doctor of Laws degree from Holy Cross and was made a Knight of Malta by Pope Pius XII in 1941 and served as a member of the Advisory Council at Boston College for twenty-five years, and

WHEREAS:-

John J. Hagerty not only took an active interest in civic affairs in the City of Cambridge but achieved national recognition by being appointed the head of the Reconstruction Finance Corporation in New England during the days of the great depression and also served as President of the Waltham Watch Company, and

WHEREAS:-

In his passing the members of the City Council have lost a staunch friend and a wise counsellor, now therefore be it
