- WHEREAS: The Portuguese-American Cultural Society is planning a dinner-dance to honor the Vice-Consul General of Portugal in Boston, Mr. Carlos M. da Luz Nunes, at the Hyatt Regency, Cambridge, on November 3, 1979; and
- WHEREAS: Mr. Carlos Nunes was born in Macau, on August 12, 1895. He studied at the Seminário de São José, Macau. From 1940 to 1969 he served as Vice-Consul of Portugal at Manila, Phillipines. He was a member of the Portuguese delegation to various International Conferences held in Manila. He was also several times Charge D'Affaires, ad interim, of the Embassy of Portugal in Manila. In May of 1969, he was transferred to Boston; and
- WHEREAS: Mr. Nunes holds two decorations from the Portuguese Government: the Ordem Militar and the Ordem do Império. He is also a Fourth Degree Knight of Columbus; and
- WHEREAS: Mr. Nunes is married to the former Pureza D'Eca, born in Hong Kong. Mr. and Mrs. Nunes have four children, all of whom live in this country; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council go on record as congratulating Vice-Consul General Carlos M. da Luz Nunes on the occasion of this event in his honor; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be requested to prepare a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution for Mr. Nunes to be presented to him on November 3, 1979, at the Hyatt Regency in Cambridge.
