The undersigned respectfully prays  
that he be granted a lease of city owned land ---at a rental of one hundred fifty  
dollars (\$150.00) per year for a period of not more than five (5) years; said  
parcel of land is bounded and described as follows:-

Beginning at a point in the easterly line of Portland Street at its inter-  
section with the division line between land of the City of Cambridge and land now or  
formerly of David W. Lewis Company thence running easterly along said division line  
about 96 feet; thence southerly 40 feet; thence westerly parallel to and 40 feet  
distant southerly from said division line about 95 feet to a point in the easterly line  
of Portland Street; thence northerly along said easterly line about 41 feet to the  
point of beginning, containing about 4000 square feet.

IN CITY COUNCIL

March 1, 1938.

## ORDERED:-

That His Honor, the Mayor, be and hereby is authorized in the name and in behalf of the City of Cambridge to lease to Joseph Wallace of 344 Columbia Street, Cambridge at the rate of not less than One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.) per year, for a period of not more than five (5) years beginning April 1, 1938, a parcel of City Land situated as follows:

Beginning at a point in the easterly line of Portland Street at its intersection with the division line between land of the City of Cambridge and land now or formerly of David W. Lewis Company thence running easterly along said division line about 96 feet; thence southerly 40 feet; thence westerly parallel to and 40 feet distant southerly from said division line about 95 feet to a point in the easterly line of Portland Street; thence northerly along said easterly line about 41 feet to the point of beginning, containing about 4,000 square feet.

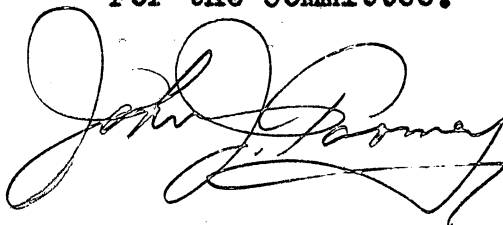
