ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct DPW Commissioner Haley to take immediate steps to assure that all motor vehicles belonging to DPW employees be parked within the confines of the DPW Yard and not on Norfolk and/or Tremont Streets during the employees' working hours; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to report back to this Council by September 14, 1992 with confirmation that such policy is in place and operative.
