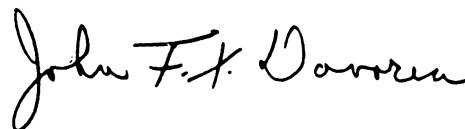

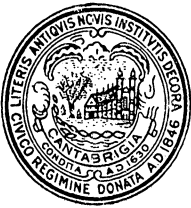

Pursuant to a communication from the Secretary of State re: "B. A. N. T. U., Inc.," I made an investigation.

The applicants live at the addresses given and have not been engaged in the illegal sale of alcoholic beverages as defined in Chapter 138, Section One nor have they been engaged in any other business or vocation prohibited by law.

"The above named applicants have not been engaged in the illegal selling of alcoholic beverages, as defined in Section One of Chapter 138, or in keeping places or tenements used for illegal gaming, or in any other business or vocation prohibited by law, or are persons of ill repute."

educational or charitable function permitted by the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts to a non-profit corporation organized under Chapter 180 of the General Laws. The aforementioned powers are in furtherance of but not in limitation of the general powers conferred by Chapter 180, as amended, and as further limited by the exempt purposes set forth in Section 501(c)(3) of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code, as amended.

1. The name by which the corporation shall be known is:

B.A.N.T.U., Inc.

2. The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

To strive for unity, understanding and collective efforts among Black and Spanish speaking inmates at M.C.I. Walpole; to assist in bringing into M.C.I. Walpole more Black and Spanish speaking staff personnel (e.g. Psychologists, Psychiatrists, Social Workers, Teachers, Correctional Officers, etc.); to develop extensive Community Relations Programs; to develop a Youth Relations program to advise young people who have or are about to run afoul of the law; to utilize those community programs already established to give training and skills to our people in prison and to provide follow-up aid for those men leaving prison; to develop a Bussing program to alleviate the financial burden of transportation for families and friends so they can remain in close contact with inmates; to develop educational and vocational programs geared to the needs of the inmates; to develop a family Welfare Program (so that those in possession of material goods can extend a helping hand to those who are not in possession of material goods); to develop a Legal Assistance Program so inmates can assist each other with legal matters; to raise and distribute funds for the aforesaid purposes and to carry on any (continued on additional sheet 2A)

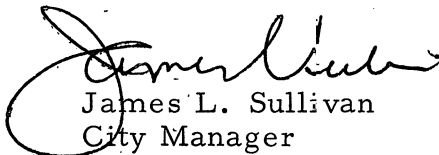
