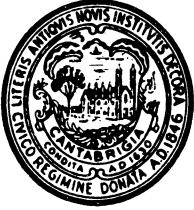

Date: July 11, 1994

Regarding the above referenced council order, Mr. Chip Norton of the Water Department has been actively involved in reviewing the Marrett Road improvement project over the past two years. Mr. Norton attended the June 14 Lexington Conservation Commission Hearing. The purpose of this meeting was for the Massachusetts Highway Department (MHD) to present their revised Notice of Intent (NOI) for this project and to address the concerns of the residents of Lexington and the City of Cambridge.

The public hearing was continued to June 21 and continued again until August 2nd at which time the hearing should be closed. The NOI is currently being reviewed by Liz Epstein, Alex Strycky and Chip Norton. The CWD will be submitting final recommendations to the Lexington Conservation Commission by July 25 regarding the Order of Conditions for this project.

This project has been certified by the Secretary of Environmental Affairs to comply with the Massachusetts Environmental Policy Act. This project also complies with all the Department of Environmental Protection's (DEP) regulations, pending a Water Quality Certificate. The only approval remaining for this project is an Order of Conditions from the Lexington Conservation Commission. Please advise if you require additional information. Thank you.
