The Board of Park Commissioners at its meeting on  
April 27, voted to inform you of the following;

The work called for in certain orders as noted below  
has been incorporated in a general project under W.P.A.,  
sponsored by the department

Order of March 9, requesting increase in height of fence on  
Western Avenue side of Russell E. Hoyt Field,.

Order of March 9, requesting that the ball diamond at  
Russell E. Hoyt Field be resurfaced.

Order of March 30, requesting that height of fence  
around Russell E. Hoyt Field be increased.

Order of March 30, requesting correction of conditions at  
Timothy F. Corcoran which cause rain water to overflow into properties  
on Walden Street side of field.

That the Water department had been requested to repair drinking  
fountain at Cambridge Field, as called for in order of March 2.

That the matter of installing new shower baths in Cambridge  
Field shelter and at Thorndike School had been referred to a

sub-committee of the Board to study and make report later; requested in  
an order of April 20.
