Dear Sir:

I beg to reply to your communication relative to the Order of the City Council of November 4, 1946, concerning proposed rates at the Golf Course.

At a meeting of the Board of Park Commissioners on September 17, 1946, the Board approved a new set of rates for the Golf Course to be effective for the season of 1947. (The rates were adopted at this time for the purpose of incorporating them in the report submitted to the special committee appointed by you to study municipal fees and charges.)

The new rates will be as follows:

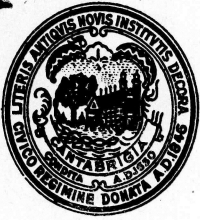
Yearly membership	\$20.00
Monthly membership	6.00
Daily greens fee	.75
Week-end and Holiday greens fee	1.25
Yearly locker fee	5.00
Monthly locker fee	1.50
Daily locker fee	.25

The above schedule makes no distinction between resident and non-resident patrons. At one time separate rates were listed for residents and non residents, but the Board is convinced that the one-rate policy has worked out much more successfully.
