- WHEREAS: Forty years ago the United Nations General Assembly adopted the Universal Declaration of Human Rights; and
- WHEREAS: The Universal Declaration for the first time committed the world community to recognize that all human beings are free and equal in dignity and rights under law; and
- WHEREAS: The promise of the Universal Declaration has yet to be honored because scores of countries still detain prisoners of conscience, prisoners of war and missing in action and carry out torture and executions; and
- WHEREAS: Amnesty International is launching its Human Rights Now! Campaign as a means to remind governments throughout the world of their obligations to respect human rights; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Council does hereby join with Amnesty International in declaring its support for the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and its commitment to protect human rights impartially throughout the world.
