In Board of Aldermen, June 16th 1869.

The Committee on Roads and Bridges would submit the following report on the petitions of G. B. H. Fuller et al and Abner Spencer et al for the widening of Essex St.

They find that the improvements asked for would cost upwards of Five Thousand and Dollars (\$5,000) and as there is no appropriation from which to take the money the present year, the committee do not believe that the necessity is of such a nature as to warrant them in recommending the creation of a City debt for the purpose of making this improvement, public travel being well accommodated on the two great through streets on either side of this street (viz. Norfolk & Prospect Sts.) They therefore recommend that the petitioners be granted leave to withdraw.
