To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the transfer of \$22,400.00 in the Block Grant Fund of the Department of Human Services from the Other Ordinary Maintenance Account to the Salary and Wages Account. This transfer serves three purposes. First, based on a past Community Development Block Grant Public Hearing, a need was identified for an Asian Services Resources Assessment Project. This transfer will fund a part time (20 hours per week) internship position which was created to assess the Cambridge Community's Asian population and available services. Next, this transfer will fund expanded Haitian Services Outreach in collaboration with the Tobacco Education Program. Last, this transfer will provide additional staff support for Block Grant management.
