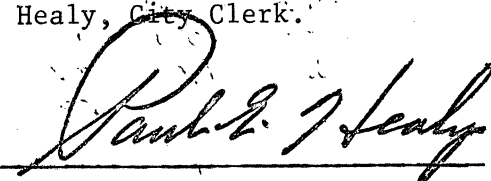

- WHEREAS: Only upon an intensive investigation and concentration of patrol units, a suspect was apprehended and a confession obtained; and
- WHEREAS: Cambridge Fire Department Arson Squad Inspectors Edward J. Fowler and Thomas C. Levins, in conjunction with Cambridge Police Sergeant Timothy Hogan and Officer Joseph Savioli conducted the investigation which brought a halt to this particular criminal activity and once again shows the exemplary talent of the members of our public safety community; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its heartfelt gratitude and appreciation to Firefighters Edward J. Fowler and Thomas C. Levins and Police Sergeant Timothy Hogan and Officer Joseph Savioli for their dedication to duty and for conducting this investigation in the usual high standards of their respective Departments; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to each member of the investigative team, as well as to the Chief of the Fire Department and the Chief of the Police Department for inclusion in their personnel files.
