WHEREAS: On Saturday, May 13th at 4p.m., Who-Ya-Whit Productions President, Ray Thomas will be presenting the 2nd Annual **Mike Jarvis** Alumni/Celebrity Basketball Game; and

WHEREAS: **Mike Jarvis** was named Head Coach of St. John's University on June 11, 1998; and

WHEREAS: **Mike Jarvis** has had a 25 year coaching record of 489-189(.721) leading the Red Storm to 28 wins, the school's third best total including becoming the N.C.A.A. "Sweet Sixteen" participant at George Washington in 1993; and

WHEREAS: **Mike Jarvis** surpassed Coach Rick Pitino as Boston University's all-time winningest men's basketball coach with a 101-51 record; and

WHEREAS: **Mike Jarvis** is a seven time NCAA participant – 1998 "Elite Eight" with St. John's 1996, 94, 93 and 1988 at The George Washington University as well as 1990 and 1988 at Boston University; and

WHEREAS: **Mike Jarvis** is a four-time (N.I.T.) National Invitational Tournament participant – 1995, and 1991 at the George Washington University, and 1986 at Boston University; and

WHEREAS: **Mike Jarvis** was the U.S.A. Olympic Trials Assistant Coach in 1988 and 1980 as well as the USA Olympic Festival, Head Coach, (East Squad-Silver Medal) 1993; and

WHEREAS: **Mike Jarvis** was the assistant coach of the U.S.A. Basketball Men's 22 and under team winning the Silver in 1993; and

- WHEREAS: **Mike Jarvis** was the Head Coach of the U.S.A. Basketball Men's 22 and under World Championship Team, Spain winning the gold Medal, 1993 and being named Assistant Coach to 1998 USA World Championship Team; and
- WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge is proud to say that **Mike Jarvis** led Cambridge Rindge and Latin to 3 consecutive state championships (81,80, & 79) while posting a 77-1 record and number one national ranking in 1981; and
- WHEREAS: **Mike Jarvis** is well known for coaching Cambridge Rindge & Latin High School All Americans Patrick Ewing and Rumeal Robinson; and
- WHEREAS: **Mike Jarvis** was the Head Coach of the East Squads in the Dapper Dan and McDonald's All Star Game in 1981; and
- WHEREAS: **Mike Jarvis** has received numerous coaching honors, including 1999 Coach of the Year from the Black Coaches Association; 1999 Coach of the Year, NCAA District II; 1999 Coach of the Year, Metropolitan Basketball Coaches Association; 1999 Coach of the Year, New York Basketball Coaches Association; four time Massachusetts High School Coach of the Year (1985, 1981, 1980 & 1979); North Atlantic Conference Coach of the Year, 1990; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City of Cambridge recognize all of **Mike Jarvis'** community efforts and great achievements as a wonderful Cantabrigian and role model; and now therefore be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City of Cambridge declare May 13th **Mike Jarvis Day** in the City of Cambridge.

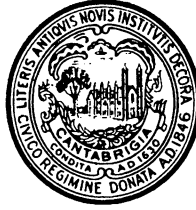
