

To the Honorable the Mayor and Aldermen
of the City of Cambridge -

The undersigned respectfully pray that Market
street may be extended and laid out forty feet wide
from its present terminus at Elm street across Elm
street, Norfolk street and Tremont street to Gardner
street, thence through and over Gardner street widen-
ing the latter to the width of forty feet, thence in
nearly a straight line to Cambridge street, so as to
pass through and include a private avenue known
as Greenough avenue between Highland and Ellsworth
avenues, and meeting Cambridge street near its
junction with Ellery street.
