ORDERED:

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to transmit this order to the Police Chief with the idea of implementing the selective police enforcement, forthwith, and be it further

ORDERED:

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to report back to this City Council in one week the action taken by him pursuant to this order.
