Equicom proposes to offer telephone services to traffic aggregators, such as hotels, motels, hospitals and universities. The Company also proposes to offer live and automated operator services.

Application of Equicom Communications, Inc., under the provisions of Chapter 159 of the General Laws, as amended, for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a resale, value-added or interexchange common carrier within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.
