- WHEREAS: The original Peabody School located on the site of the present structure, was founded in 1889, and named for Andrew Peabody, a minister, professor, editor and member of the Cambridge School Committee for 12 years, from 1870 through 1882. This original structure stood firm on Linnaean Street until the spring of 1960 when the last class graduated from what has become known as "the old building". On February 6, 1962, the students and faculty returned to 44 Linnaean Street; and
- WHEREAS: A flag raising ceremony will be held on February 14th, 1989 to dedicate the new Peabody School flag; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending our sincere congratulations to the Peabody School staff as they celebrate and mark this event; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the Peabody School on behalf of the entire City Council.
