AN ORDINANCE

In amendment to an ordinance entitled: "The General Ordinances of the City of Cambridge" as revised in 1972 and now designated as "The Code of the City of Cambridge".

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge as follows:
Chapter Twelve entitled: "Licenses and Permits" Section Eleven entitled: "Automatic Music Machines; Licenses; Exceptions; Reports" is hereby amended by striking out the present paragraph (c) and substituting in place thereof a new paragraph (c) which reads as follows:-

(c) Licenses granted for the maintenance, possession and operation of such automatic music machines shall be issued annually to expire on December Thirty-First of each year. The charge for such license shall be Twenty-Five (\$25.00) Dollars for each machine. Any machine arranged for operation of more than one outlet shall, for the purpose of such license fee, be regarded as one machine.
