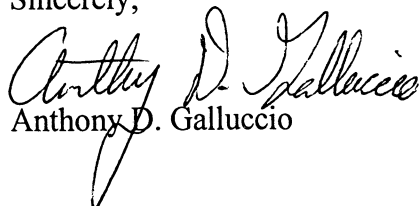
Dear President Rudenstine;

I am writing to emphatically urge Harvard University to adopt a responsible employer plan comparable to the City of Cambridge's Responsible Employer ordinance. I am writing to support the demands of Painters Union members as I have previously supported the efforts of other building trade unions.

The City has recognized the benefits of employing trade unions members who have learned their trade by going through rigorous apprenticeship programs under the supervision of highly skilled workers. I support the importance of all Cambridge institutions following the City's lead and adopting their own responsible employer plans modeled on the City's program.

It is time for Harvard to join with the City and other Cambridge institutions to protect the rights of workers, provide fair wages for work done, and promote the advantages of employing highly trained workers for skilled work. I appreciate your prompt attention to this matter.
