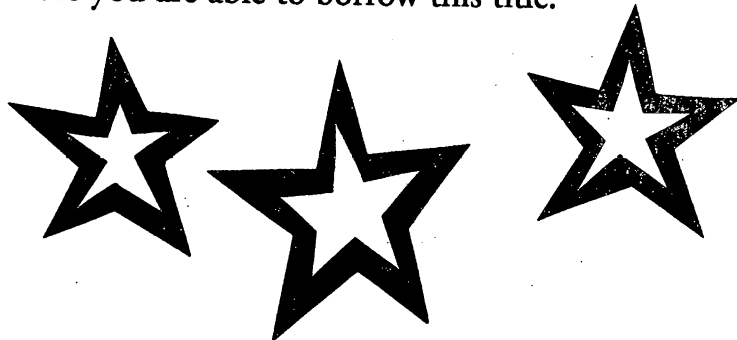
News, New Program:
