An Ordinance

in addition to the Ordinance in relation to Streets.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge, as follows:-

No person shall suffer his wagon, cart, sled, or other vehicle, to remain an unnecessary length of time on any sidewalk, or in any street, lane, or alley of the City; and any person violating this Ordinance shall forfeit and pay a sum not exceeding twenty dollars.
