- 2A. The purpose of this corporation is to promote equality between the sexes.

The officers, directors and members of this corporation intend to do this in the following ways:

1. Through in depth studies of how the legal system reflects culturally established differentiations between the sexes.
2. By résearch into areas of law in which discrimination based on sex are found to exist.
3. To analyze and compare the legal systems of other countries in this regard.
4. To write about, and from time to time publish, the results of this work.
5. To prepare and distribute a set of educational materials on the above topics.
6. To work with, and provide educational resources to, groups with similar purposes.
7. To carry on any other educational function permitted by the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts to a non-profit corporation organized under Chapter 180. The aforementioned powers are in furtherance of but not in limitation of the general powers conferred by Chapter 180 of the General Laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts as amended and as further limited by the exempt purposes set forth in the appropriate section of 501 (c) of the United States Internal Revenue Code as amended.
