

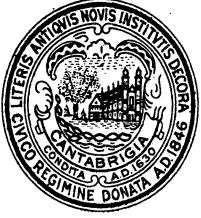
We understand that with this payment permission to connect the Cage to the common sewer will be granted.
