WHEREAS: Several issues were discussed which need to be addressed; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the following items be referred to the City Manager's office for action from the appropriate departments:

- 1) Inspect lighting on Cambridge Terrace and Raymond Street to see if it is adequate;
- 2) Trees trimmed on Cambridge Terrace and Raymond Street;
- 3) Blind corner at Richdale & Upland Road due to high fence, dangerous exiting Richdale onto Upland. Additional warning sign may be necessary;
- 4) Areas of traffic enforcement:
  - a) Excessive violation of one-way traffic on Harvey Street;
  - b) Violations of "No U-turn" on Mass Avenue;
  - c) Heavy trucking on Rindge Avenue;
  - d) Permit Parking violations during night time;
  - e) Vehicles parked too near corners of streets (especially Clay Street & Rindge Avenue) making turns difficult.

- 5) Lack of adequate number of Police Details during construction causing confusion due to the number of streets affected by road work.
- 6) Concern again was voiced regarding the placement of the traffic light at Sherman Street near Danehy Park at the entrance of Walden Square; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to report back to the City Council.
