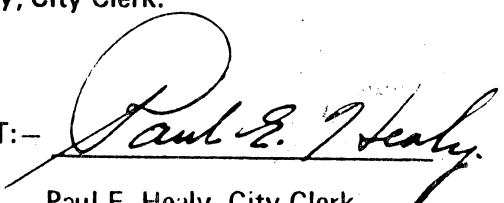

- WHEREAS:** It was with profound sorrow that this City Council learned of the passing of Attorney Edward A. Crane, former Mayor of the City of Cambridge on August 4, 1982 at the age of sixty-eight years, and
- WHEREAS:** Edward A. Crane, the son of Timothy and Mary Crane was born on February 15, 1914, attended Cambridge High and Latin School and graduated from Harvard College where he attained Phi Beta Kappa Honors in 1935 prior to entering Harvard Law School and his admission to the Bar of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts in 1939; and
- WHEREAS:** Edward A. Crane was elected by his colleagues to serve as Mayor of the City of Cambridge for four terms in 1950, 1960, 1962 and 1964 under the Plan E Charter and earned the respect of his colleagues and contemporaries by his leadership, dedication to sound fiscal policies, his ability to reconcile divergent points of view and resolve difficult issues through compromise; and
- WHEREAS:** Edward A. Crane was a tower of strength in the political life of the City of Cambridge, a man of many talents who served his community by membership on the Board of Directors of the Community Fund, Red Cross, Boy Scouts and as a Trustee of the Harvard Trust and the Columbian Cooperative Banks and achieved high honors as a champion golfer whose accomplishments are recorded in plaques in clubhouses in the Suburban Greater Boston Area, and
- WHEREAS:** His passing will be sorely felt by the members of his family, his many friends and associates and the citizens of Cambridge, now therefore be it
- RESOLVED:** That the City Council of the City of Cambridge, in regular session assembled, on this twentieth day of September 1982, does hereby express its sincere sympathy and condolences to his devoted wife Mary and the members of his family and adjourns this meeting in honor and memory of Edward A. Crane, former Councilman and Mayor of the City of Cambridge, and be it further
- RESOLVED:** That a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution be prepared and presented to Mr. Crane's family in testimonial of our love and respect for our late colleague.
