ORDERED:

That in order to assist the voters of Cambridge to determine how they wish to vote on Question Two on the November ballot (Proposition 2½), it is ordered that the City Council will hold a mock budget hearing on Monday, October 27, 1980 at 7:30 P. M., at which the City Manager is requested to present, in regular budget format (but abbreviated form) a recommended projected budget for the five years over which the Proposition 2½ reductions would occur, showing just what the impact on city services and employment might involve, by way of reduced police protection, increased classroom sizes, reduced special education, reduced library services, reduced health services, reduced refuse collection, reduced snow removal, etc.
