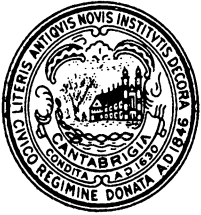

To the Honorable, the City Council:


This will advise your Honorable Body that I have established a Cambridge Census Review Committee as set forth in the attachment to this letter.

The functions of this committee, under the leadership of its Chairman, Mr. John Pitkin of the Harvard-M.I.T. Joint Center for Urban Studies, are to:

1. Support and assist the Census Bureau's Cambridge District Office in every way possible as it moves through the various stages of the census process to a finalization of its count in mid-August;
2. Refine our own Cambridge dwelling unit and population estimates for use in reviewing the Census Bureau's preliminary figures when received in the latter part of June.

As indicated in the attached listing, we have also established a technical sub-committee within the full Cambridge Census Review Committee. Members of this sub-committee and their staff associates have been at work for several months on the above projects. Community Development Staff members under Assistant City Manager David Vickery have updated our dwelling unit totals by block over a period of years, and will continue to provide the principle staff support for the census work to be accomplished by the Committee.
