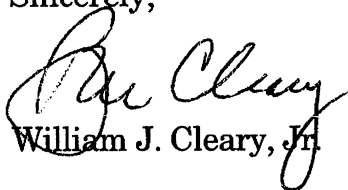
Dear Sandra:
