Pay Phone, Inc. ("Pay Phone") seeks to provide alternative operator service ("AOS") and transmission services within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. Pay Phone would provide AOS from hotels, motels, and privately-owned pay telephones.

The above investigation is officially captioned:

Application of Pay Phone, Inc. to the Department of Public Utilities, under the provisions of Chapter 159 of the General Laws, as amended, for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a resale, value-added, or interexchange common carrier within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.
