I wish to inform you that I have completed a study of the South Pearl Street Area as requested by the City Council and have made the following improvements.

1. Installed new signs at all school crossings,
2. Cross hatched the school crosswalks adjacent to the school,
3. Instituted a Resident Sticker Program which has helped,
4. Installed a warning beacon at Allston St. and Brookline Street,
5. Assisted the Police Department in a stricter enforcement of the traffic laws,
6. Will reevaluate the one way system in the area with a view toward eliminating through traffic.

I will talk with the neighborhood groups on these subjects and do whatever is necessary to make these streets safer.

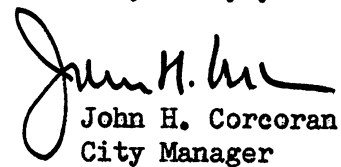
