willing that your Honorable Board should fix

any claims to damages, provided we are not to be
at any time assessed for betterments for this Street
or for the laying out or improvements of any of the
Streets or territory adjoining or communicating with our
estate or this Street in the future also reserving our
rights to claim compensation for filling the land
which we have filled by order of the City.
