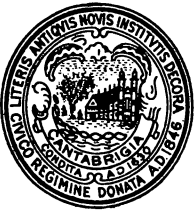


Dear Sir:

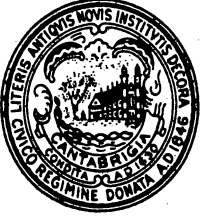


To the Honorable, the City Council,
