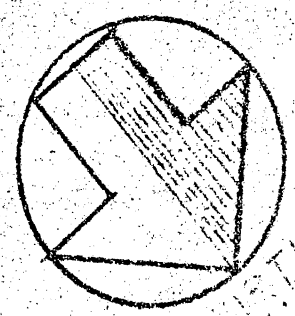
MEET EXISTING PAVING

BY 23.75 PAVING

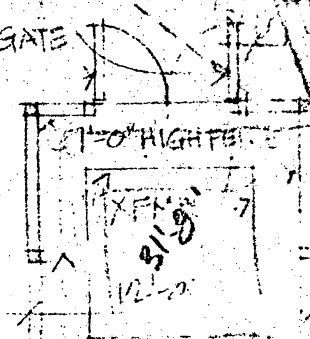

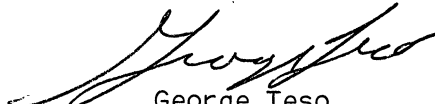

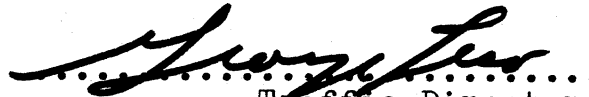
