The Public Works Department this year in its budget included \$35,000 for repairs to greenhouse number 1 and 4, plus the passageway between 2 and 3. This appropriation was insufficient to do the entire greenhouse work. It had been estimated to cost \$80,000, however, the work has been scheduled through emergency work that was immediately required to maintain the operations of the facilities.

It is the departments intention to complete the repairs over the next few years gradually. The greenhouse is typical of many of the city's facilities that have been frightfully neglected.

This year the department has made very good progress in correcting many of these problems. However, it will be many years before all the work that needs to be done is completed.

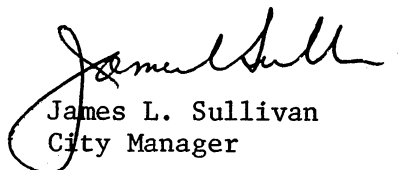
