- WHEREAS: Parks, fields, and green areas in general are a precious commodity in a city; and
- WHEREAS: All citizens, particularly children, youth, and older people utilize these areas for relaxation and recreation; and
- WHEREAS: For a variety of reasons, play areas, fields, and parks have been inadequately maintained; therefore, be it
- ORDERED: That the Cambridge City Council requests the City Manager to prepare a work plan, staffing and budget that will allow
1. proper maintenance and cleanliness of all play areas, parks, and fields
 2. capital improvements, where needed, of a quality that will allow continued proper maintenance, including facilities for keeping these spaces watered;
- and be it further
- ORDERED: That the overall objective of the plan be to have the neighborhood and city-wide parks be an outstanding municipal service.
