To The Honorable, The City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of a grant from the Department of Public Welfare for \$3,000,000 to the Health & Hospital Services Salaries & Wages Account (\$500,000) and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$2,500,000) to provide funds for the development, implementation and expansion of health care programs to provide a "safety net" for patient populations who have historically been medically underserved. These programs include services to protect low income people with AIDS, substance abuse and addictions, trauma victims, high risk mothers and the neonates, and indigent patients without access to care who are often homeless. The administrative staff of the hospital is currently in the process of developing specific programs to meet the above-mentioned needs. It is expected that a large portion of the funds will be used to offset significant Department of Mental Health and Department of Public Health budget reductions.

Additionally, in response to a recommendation to fund the Cambridge-Somerville Program for Alcohol Rehabilitation (CASPAR) Intervention Center, \$225,000 has been allocated to keep the free-standing detoxification center open.
