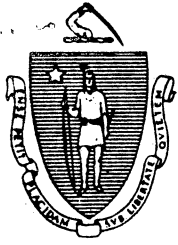

THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter ninety-five of the Acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-two is hereby amended by deleting the first sentence of section one and by replacing it with the following language:

There is hereby established in the city of Cambridge a board of license commissioners to consist of the chief of the fire department, the commissioner of the police department or his or her designee, and a third commissioner to be appointed by the city manager, subject to the provisions of the city charter, for a term of three years.

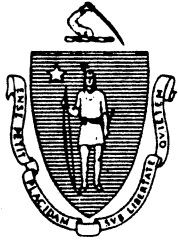

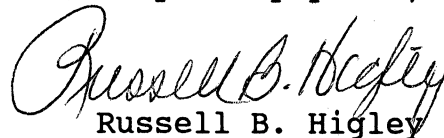

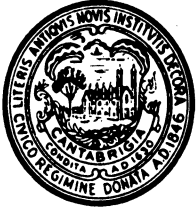
Dear Mr. Healy:
