WHEREAS: Over and above her contributions to the people of Cambridge, Sylvia brought that same spirit of caring and sharing to the enormous work she has done for the Jewish War Veterans, this on the local, state and national levels; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record to express its appreciation to Sylvia R. Piltch for her person and presence as a dedicated human being and employee of the City of Cambridge. Further, that this Council, aware that while Sylvia may retire from the life of her job but never from the job of her life, wishes her well in all that she will undertake; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and is requested to prepare a duly engrossed copy of this Resolution for presentation to the new retiree.
