Dear Mayor Galluccio,

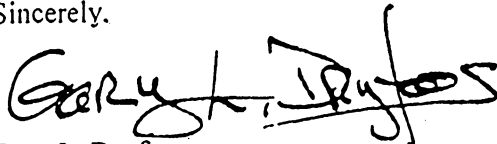
