Dr. McGovern was a graduate of Boston College in the class of 1923 and interned at St. Elizabeth's Hospital and Boston City Hospital after his graduation from Tufts Medical School in 1927, and

Dr. McGovern was recognized as an outstanding obstetrician and gynecologist and served on the staff of the Cambridge Hospital, St. Elizabeth's Hospital and Boston City Hospital and was a past president of the Cambridge Medical Improvement Society and a founding fellow of the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists and a fellow of the International College of Surgeons, and

Dr. McGovern will be best remembered by many mothers in the City of Cambridge who remember his twenty-four hour vigils in the Cambridge Hospital and particularly during the early morning hours when he was always available to render assistance and a kind word and a renewal of courage during their hours of trial, therefore be it
