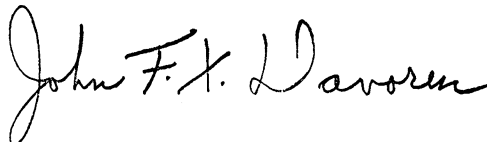

1. The name by which the corporation shall be known is:

ALLIANCE FOR A SAFER GREATER BOSTON, INC.

2. The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

to research, formulate, devise and conduct public educational programs and related activities designed to further and achieve the shaping of a safer Greater Boston through the concern of its respective citizens with the abatement of problems and conditions of crime, fear of crime and the causes of crime prevalent in its respective areas; the said purposes, programs and activities are designed to counteract repressive concepts and activities whether by extremists of the right or left and to prevent the appropriation by them of issues of crime and violence for repressive or similar ulterior aims; and to do any and all things necessary or incidental to these purposes under Chapter 180 of the General laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

(j) to have and exercise all powers necessary or convenient to effect any or all of the purposes for which the corporation is formed; and

(k) to have and possess all rights, privileges and powers now or hereafter conferred by the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts upon charitable corporations organized under such laws.

The corporation shall have and may exercise in furtherance of its corporate purposes the following powers:

(a) to purchase, receive, take by grant, gift, devise, bequest or otherwise, lease, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, improve, employ, use and otherwise deal in and with, real or personal property, or any interest therein, wherever situated;

(b) to sell, convey, lease, exchange, transfer or otherwise dispose of, or mortgage, pledge, encumber or create a security interest in, all or any of its property, or any interest therein, wherever situated;

(c) to purchase, take, receive, subscribe for, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, vote, employ, sell, lend, lease, exchange, transfer, or otherwise dispose of, mortgage, pledge, use and otherwise deal in and with, bonds and other obligations, shares, or other securities or interests issued by others, whether engaged in similar or different business, governmental, or other activities;

(d) to make contracts, give guarantees and incur liabilities, borrow money at such rates of interest as the corporation may determine, issue its notes, bonds and other obligations, and secure any of its obligations by mortgage, pledge or encumbrance of, or security interest in, all or any of its property or any interest therein, wherever situated;

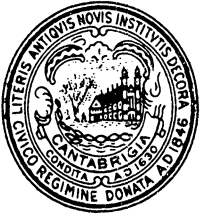
(e) to lend money, invest and reinvest its funds, and take and hold real and personal property as security for the payment of funds so loaned or invested;

(f) to do business, carry on its operations, and have offices and exercise the powers granted by this chapter in any jurisdiction within or without the United States;

(g) to pay pensions, establish and carry out pension, profit-sharing, share bonus, share purchase, share option, savings, thrift and other retirement, incentive and benefit plans, trusts and provisions for any or all of its directors, officers and employees, and for any or all of the directors, officers and employees of any corporation, fifty percent or more of the shares of which outstanding and entitled to vote on the election of directors are owned, directly or indirectly, by it;

(h) to be an incorporator of other corporations of any type or kind;

(i) to be a partner in any enterprise which, pursuant to these Articles, the corporation would have power to conduct by itself;
