Under the city ordinance, any company, business or person shall come before the Pole and Conduit Commission for permission to locate a public telephone which encroaches on the public way.

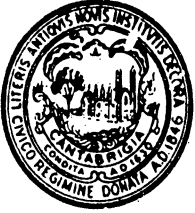
We have been instructing any company or person that they must make application and be heard before the Pole and Conduit Commission, which meets every third Thursday of the month. Any phone which does not have permission to encroach on the public way, shall be removed. Location and placement of any public telephone on public property and encroaching the public way, must receive approval from the Pole and Conduit Commission.

I enclose copies of letters that went out to the companies that have located payphones at Spring and Sciarappa Streets-Alltec, Ltd. and at Third and Cambridge Streets-New England Payphone, Inc.. There are currently no payphones at Fifth and Cambridge Streets.

It has been determined that a number of your payphones have been placed in Cambridge, particularly at Spring and Sciarappa Street, without the permission of the Pole and Conduit Commission.

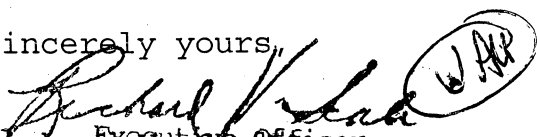
Permission is required to be located on the public way or overhanging the public way as outlined under M.G.L. c. 166, s.21 and Cambridge City Ordinances c.15.16.

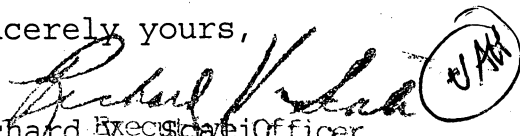
