In City Council,

October 6, 1969.

ORDERED:-

That His Honor the Mayor designate three members of the City Council to confer with the President of the Senate, Maurice Donahue, to provide for the passage of enabling legislation related to the following proposals -

1. Establish maximum rents for housing accommodations in the city;
2. Establish a rent board with power to adjust such maximum rents;
3. Provide for appropriate sanctions for enforcement and appropriate rights of appeal;
4. To establish the power of the City Council to enact a rent control ordinance

and be it further

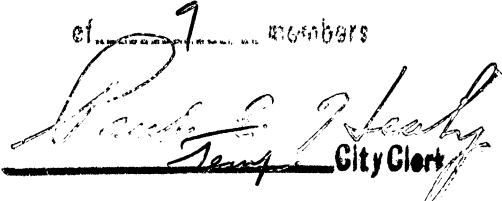
ORDERED:-
