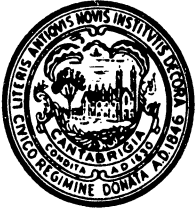
The design for the sewers in the Agassiz neighborhood is completed. Construction of the sewers for this area is presently scheduled to begin in the summer of 1996. One exception to this schedule is Sacramento Street from Mass. Avenue to Oxford Street. This area is scheduled to begin in the summer of 1995 in conjunction and in coordination with the completion of the school.

A construction schedule or sequence for 1996 has not yet been finalized. It appears that the project will be in three phases. They are:

- **Phase I** - Sacramento St (Mass Ave to Oxford Street)
Summer/Fall 1995
- **Phase II** - Quincy St (Broadway to Kirkland St) and (Kirkland St. to City Line) Summer 1996
- **Phase III** - Oxford St (Kirkland to City Line) and (all affected side streets off Oxford St.) late Fall 1996

This project is expected to take 18 to 24 months for completion. Detailed information that will be of interest to the community will begin to become available in the next few months. Public Works intends to schedule community meetings in the area prior to construction to provide information and to accommodate neighborhood concerns.
